Investment attractiveness and transaction parameters

- The Company is the owner and operator of coastal infrastructure facilities, rendering a wide range of logistics and production services to support oil operations in the Kazakhstani sector of the Caspian Sea (KSCS)
- The main asset of the Company "North Caspian Sea Terminal" has a strategically advantageous location and is the closest onshore infrastructure to the Kashagan field. It has a high potential to render services for the expansion of the Kashagan field
- The Company assets in Mangystau region have been involved in the development of all exploration wells in the Kazakh sector of the Caspian Sea and have the potential to support future offshore field development projects in KSCS
- The Company has implemented the following projects: a freght transportation route, berth for the shipment of rock, drilling mud production plant, etc.
- One of the promising complex projects of the Company is the construction of a marine logistics hub, which will include a support base for marine operations, grain and coal terminal, terminal for the shipment of petroleum products and terminal for the processing of general freight
