



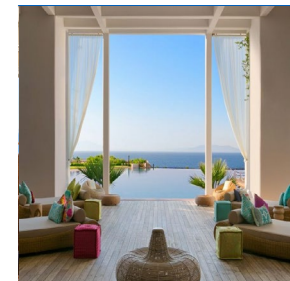
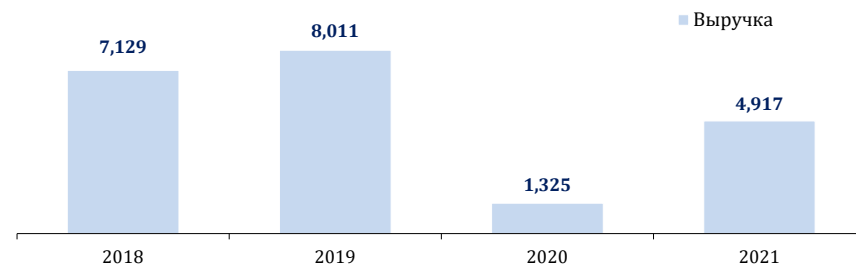

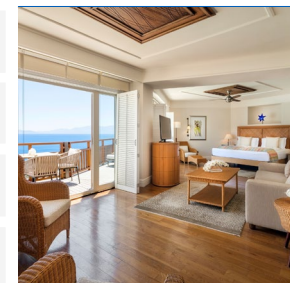

Investment attractiveness and transaction parameters

- The Company manages the asset - the Kempinski Hotel Barbaros Bay Bodrum, a five-star resort located on the cliff of Barbaros Bay
- The hotel provides 173 rooms for guests and all the infrastructure for recreation and accommodation (6 restaurants, 3 bars, spa complex, fitness center, etc.)
- There are 3 residences located around the hotel: Barbaros Bay, Barbaros Reserve and Barbaros Valley
- The hotel itself is managed by Kempinski Hotel S. A. until 2025 in accordance with the management agreement with the Company
- The land on which the hotel was built was leased from the Turkish Treasury for a period of 49 years. The lease term will end in February 2047. According to the license agreement, the Company will pay 1% of revenue annually

The realization of a 75% stake in the Company to the strategic investor is being considered
